The Board believes that social activities in school life assist students in learning how to enjoy worthwhile group events, how to conduct themselves at group events, and how to contribute to the enjoyment of others at group events. Therefore school groups and classes may use the District's facilities to hold social activities for their membership.

All social events must first be approved by the Building Principal, and it is his/her responsibility to determine that proper chaperoning is available. School organizations holding social events will be required to provide for adequate security personnel to control traffic, protect District facilities during the function, and to be on call as necessary for protecting the welfare of the participants.
